Ingredients:



Method. Take one Devon Moonraker and add to it the following ingredients:

FILLING

LIGHT INGREDIENTS

1. Driver's seat.
2. Passenger seat.
3. Rear-facing seat (storage under).
4. Extension dining seat.
5. Forward facing seat (storage under).
6. Centre-leg table.
7. Wear and stain resistant carpet throughout.
8. Daytime storage.
9. Stainless steel sink with faucet/ electric pump.
10. Drop-down work surface.
11. Refrigerator (optional extra)
12. Cooker/grill.
13. Deep storage Locker.
14. Wardrobe.
15. Large water carrier.



DARK INGREDIENTS

1. Double bed.
2. Wardrobe.
3. All-round curtains.
4. Rear facing seat (storage under).
5. Extension seat.
6. Drop-down work surface provides useful shelf space.
7. All-over carpet.

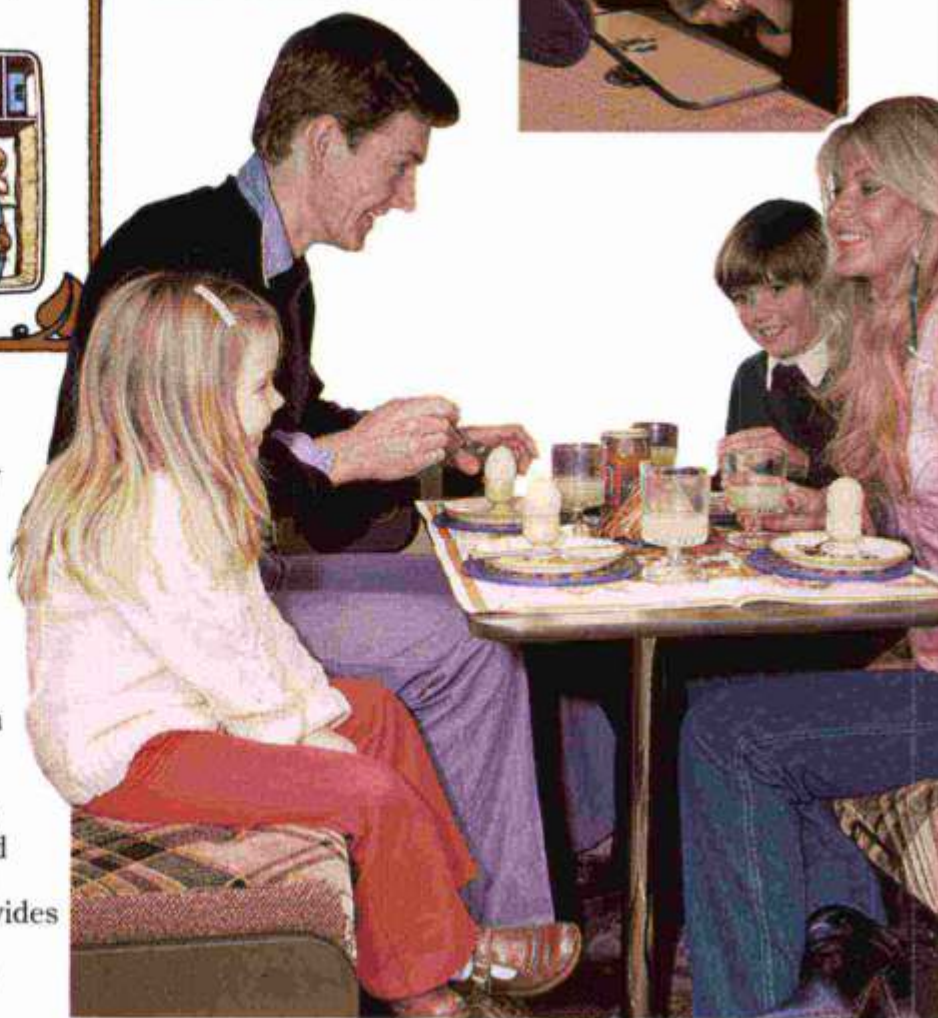


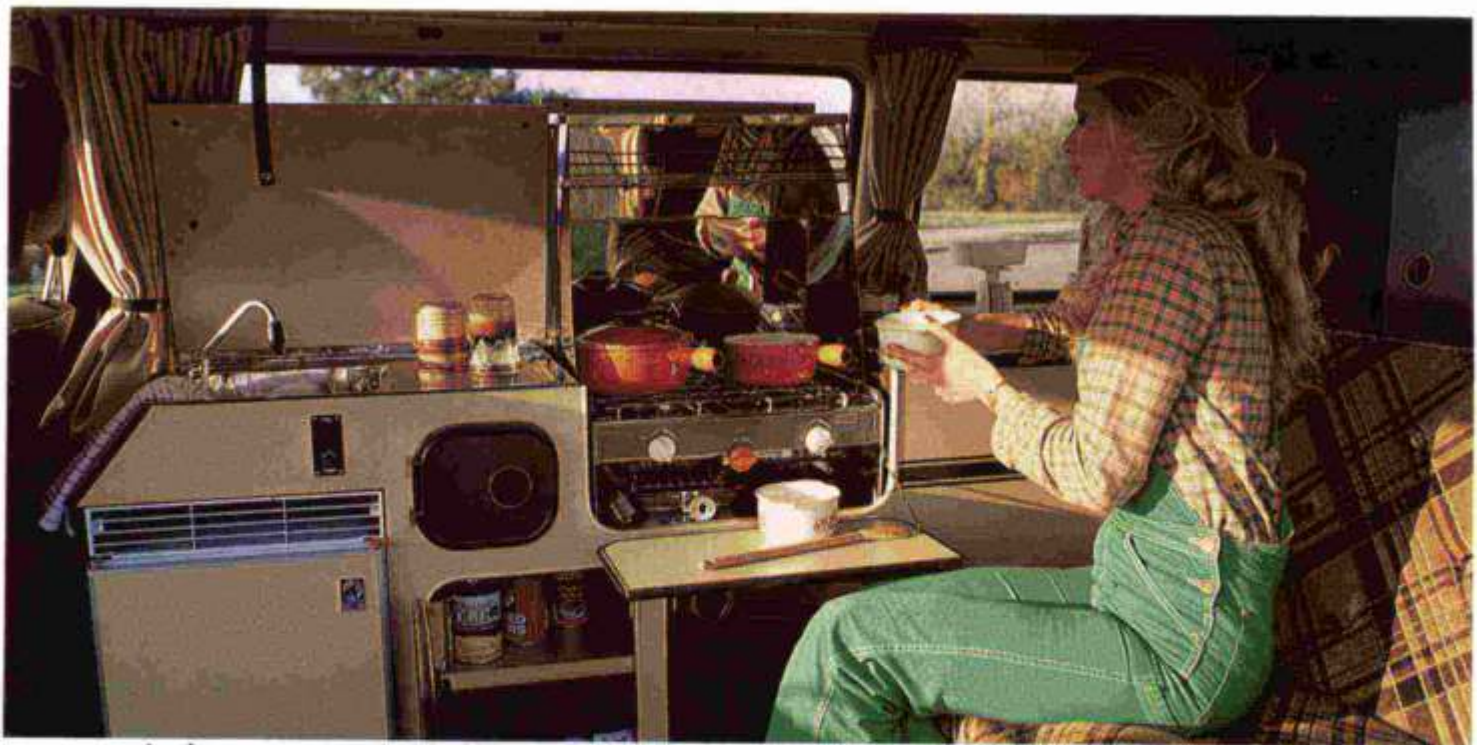
First, make the seating deliciously comfortable and adaptable.

The rear-facing single seat extends to become a 2 seater for dining, lift off the cushion and there's plenty of storage space beneath.

The rear bench seat faces forward and seats two or three people and it pulls out easily to complete a large double bed the rear seat and engine deck cushions together forming a deep foam mattress. The rear bench seat locker provides ample storage space for bedding.

At meal-times the centre leg dining table is simply located between both sets of seating.





Add a tastefully designed kitchen and storage unit.

A complete kitchen and storage unit is fitted along the offside of the vehicle. The top of the unit is a useful work top/shelf made of heat-resistant melamine, which is divided into three hinged sections.

The first section lifts to reveal a stainless steel sink unit and draining board with faucet and electric push-button water pump. An optional refrigerator can be fitted beneath the sink. There are also two cupboards – one large, shelved and with a pull-out cutlery drawer.

Concealed neatly beneath the lid of the middle section is a two-burner gas cooker with a grill and heat shield. A hinged flap drops down to provide a handy work surface whilst the cooker is in use. Beneath the cooker



there's a second large, shelved cupboard.

The end section is a deep storage locker, with a gas bottle storage cupboard beneath, vented to the outside air. The portable cool box (when an optional refrigerator is not fitted) is stored in this locker.



Blend with a generous helping of luxury.

Rich carpet-style trim covers all interior panels, in dark brown up to window level and above in beige.

The buttoned deep foam cushions are upholstered in a patterned fabric with a luxurious soft-as-velvet pile. Curtains are fitted to all windows, running on a continuous curtain track. Flotex covers the floor – a

unique carpet which combines wear and stain-resisting qualities with luxury and warmth. Cushions, curtains and floor carpet are all in toning colours.

Brushed nylon seats with head restraint add a touch of luxury for the driver and passenger. At the offside rear there's a wardrobe with a hanging rail, and a small shelf.



An elevating roof that rises beautifully.

The Moonraker's 'Double Top' fibreglass roof runs the full length of the vehicle, yet is simplicity itself to raise. Gas filled struts assist in lifting, holding the roof in the open position and taking the weight when closing. To raise the roof just give an initial push and it will open of its own accord. It's just as easy to close.

The 'Double Top' is a side hinged roof, hinged on the offside and locked down on the nearside. Catches secure it firmly for travelling.

Fill with sleeping arrangements designed for really sweet dreams.

In the elevating roof there are two solid-based mattresses. Use them as twin beds for children or push them together to form a double bed.

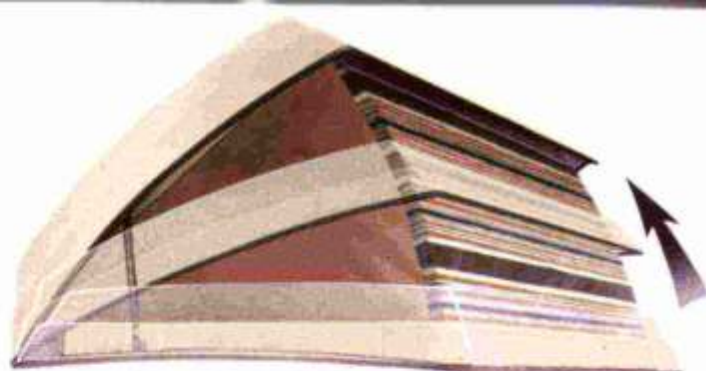
The Devon Double Top elevating roof has no

unstable overhangs, raised or lowered. You'll sleep safely and soundly.

The roof vent ensures a fresh air supply and is fitted with a fly screen.

The sleeping arrangements in the elevating roof, together with the daytime seating which converts into a large double bed, mean that the Moonraker 80 can sleep four people in real comfort. A cab bunk suitable for a young child is available as an optional extra.

Of course, if only two people are using the vehicle, the bed sections can be removed, giving more headroom.



Add a dash of style.

The 'Double Top' has a tough, good-looking vinyl roof skirt which blends with the vehicle's exterior colours.

An attractive carpet-style trim covers the interior and the undersides of the bed units.

The mattresses are covered in toning material, colour keyed to the interior upholstery.

Accompaniments.

Additional storage space is provided by the roof locker and also above the engine compartment.

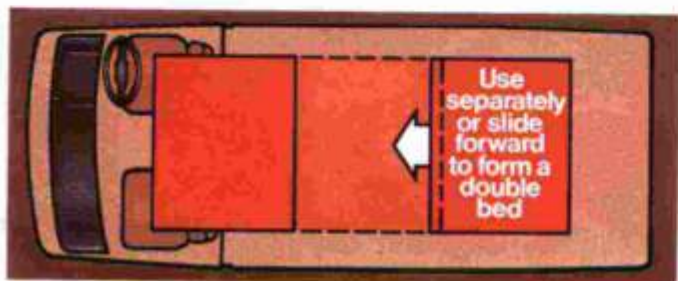
The Moonraker 80 comes equipped with plenty of interior lighting.

A 34 litre (7½ gallon) capacity water tank is fitted. The tank can be filled by removing it from the vehicle and wheeling it to a water supply, or it can be filled *in situ*.

Finishing touches.

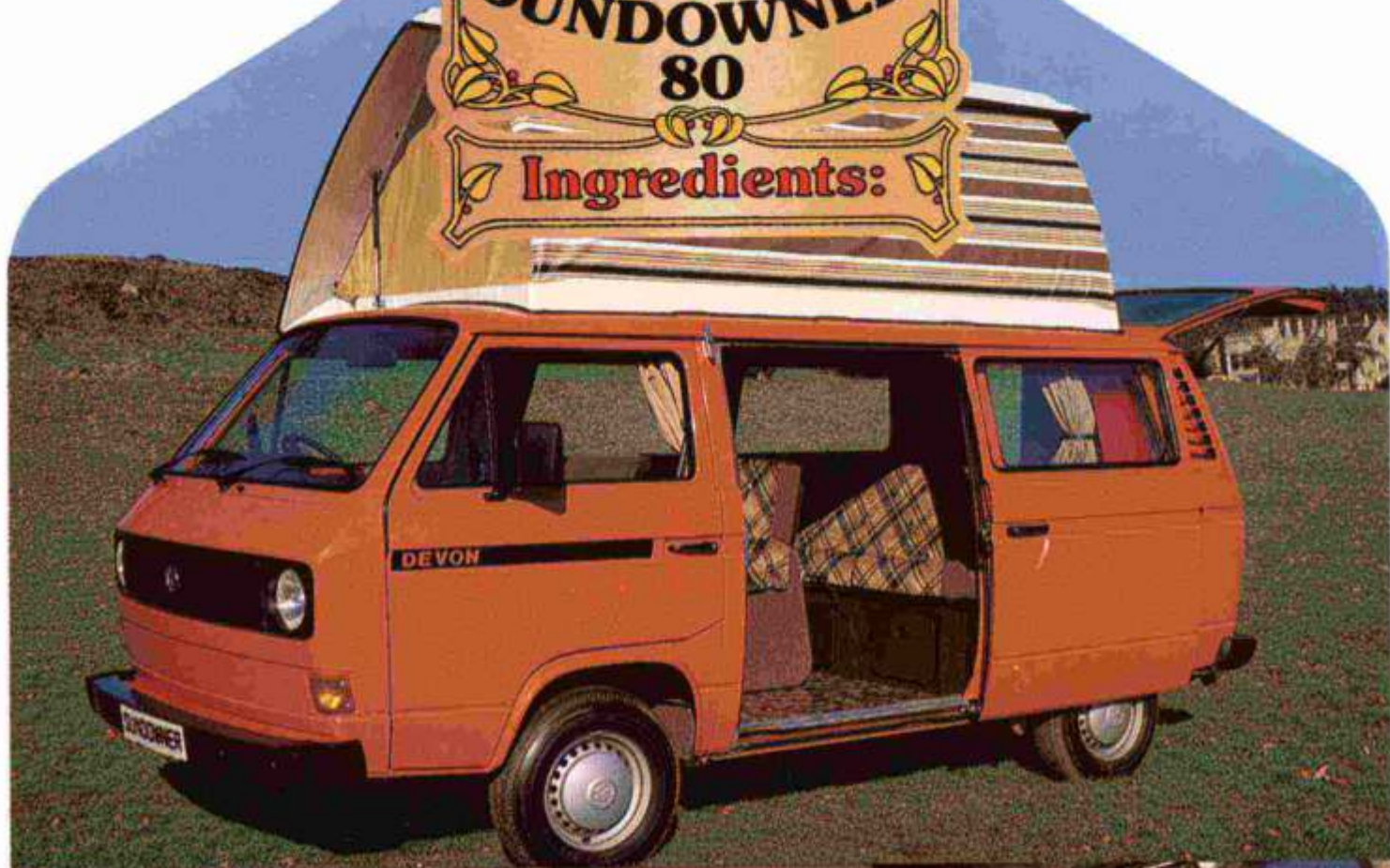
The following items are available as optional extras.

Electrolux RM 122 (12 volt/gas) refrigerator. Porta-Potti 232 chemical toilet. Child's safety seat (Kangol Universal). Fire Extinguisher. Side step. Cab hammock bunk.

Ingredients:



Just the right mix for carrying passengers in style.

The Sundowner 80 carries up to eight people in comfort on short trips or long journeys.

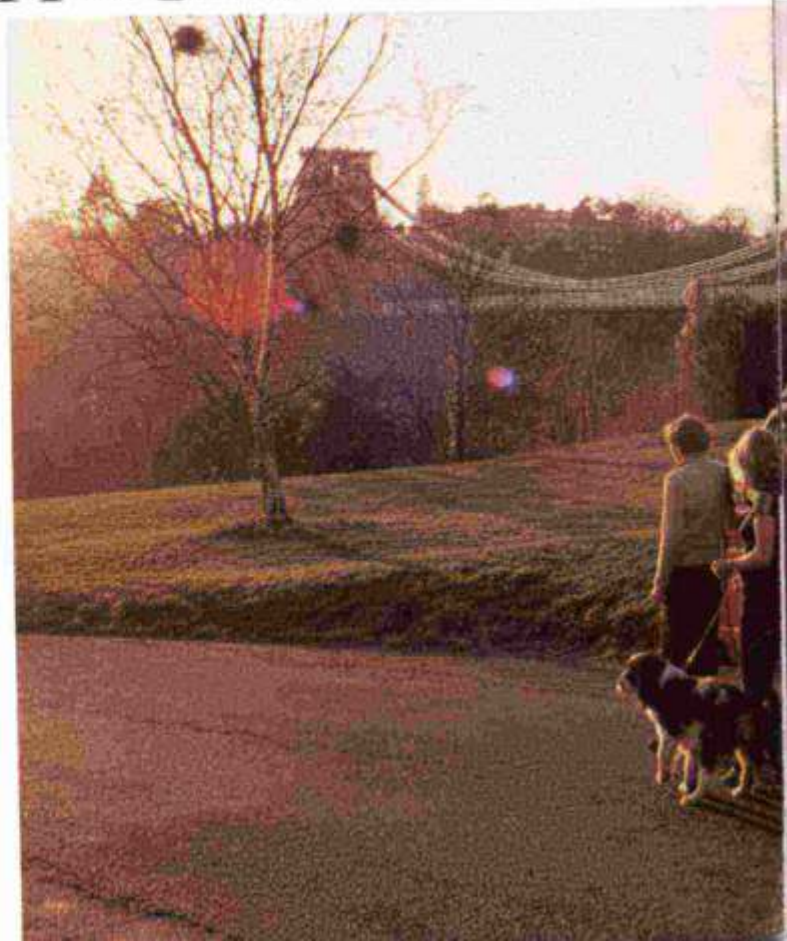
There's a rear bench seat for two or three people, with a single seat adjacent to it on the nearside. The two-seater front bench seat has a reversible backrest so passengers can face the front or rear: The seat can also be slid backwards or forwards.

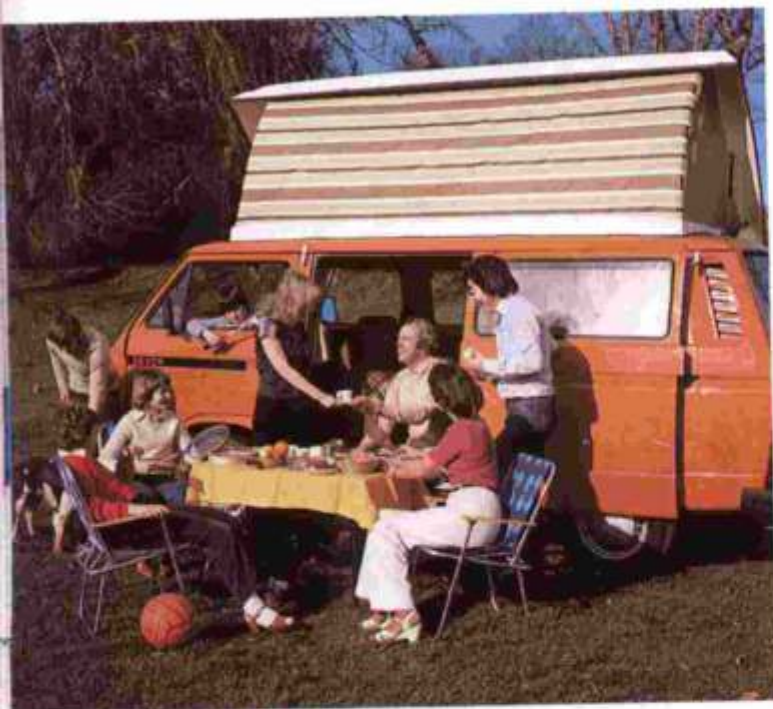
The cushions are deep foam, upholstered and buttoned in a soft, patterned velour which echoes the interior colour scheme of dark brown and beige.



With the perfect ingredients for short breaks, family outings and shopping expeditions.

There's an adaptable dining table for use inside or for a picnic outside the vehicle. For internal use the table top is located below the offside window, and supported by a single screw-in leg. Space for sitting around the table is created by sliding the front bench seat away from the rear seat.





For cooking there's a portable gas range with two burners.

When not in use the gas bottle is stored behind the backrest of the single seat (a storage cupboard vented to the outside).



The Sundowner 80 has loads of storage space, including a wardrobe with a hanging rail.

Both bench seats have spacious cupboards beneath their cushions, and there's lots of space in the engine deck storage box. Two fresh water tanks are stowed at the rear of the vehicle, each holding 11.5 litres (2½ gallons), and there's a washing-up bowl too.

Other ingredients include plenty of interior lighting, an attractive carpet-style trim to walls and ceiling, a patterned vinyl floor covering and all round curtains running on a continuous track.



And a good measure of sleeping arrangements.

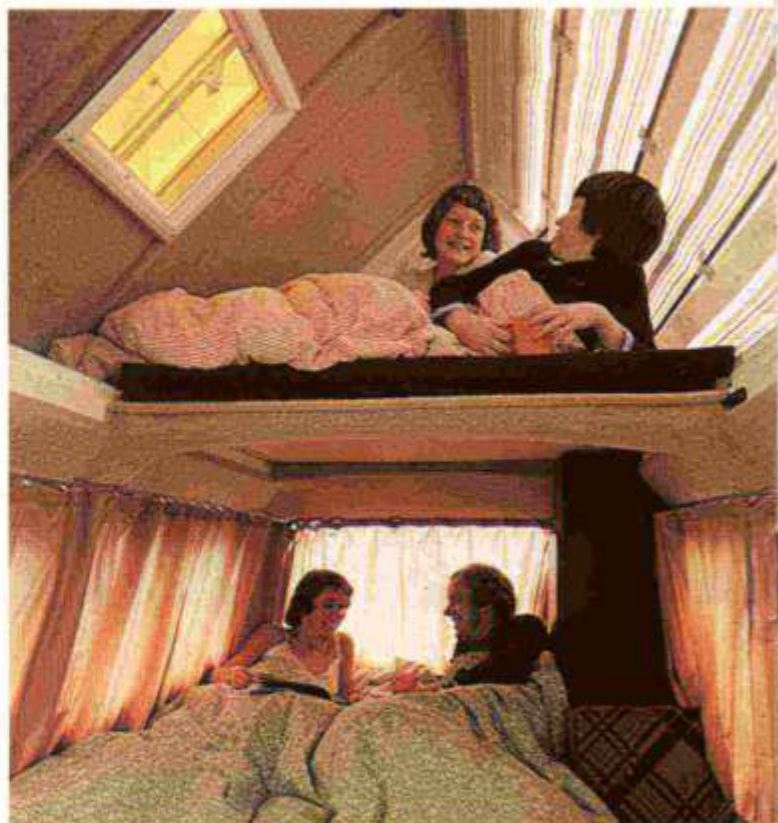
Like the Moonraker, the Sundowner 80 has the 'Double Top' elevating roof with the two bed sections which can be used separately as twin beds for children, or, as a comfortable double bed when pushed together.

Downstairs the rear bench seat pulls out easily to complete a large double bed – the rear seat and engine deck cushions forming a deep foam mattress.

Finishing touches.

The following items are available as optional extras:

Child's safety seat. Fire extinguisher. Side step. Cab bunk.



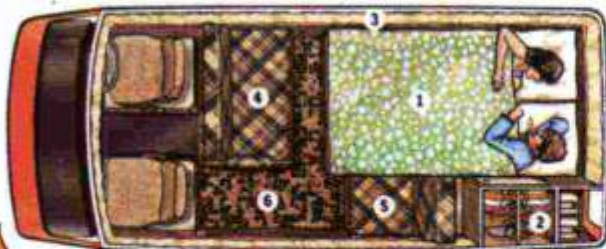

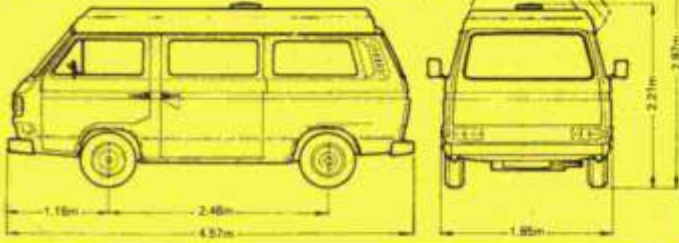
